



Roger Alan Noble, 76, passed away on Tuesday April 27, 2010 at his home in Buena Vista. Roger was the cherished husband of Carol Noble, with whom he would have celebrated his 48<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary on April 28<sup>th</sup>. He is also survived by his children Tim Noble, Cindy Noble, Candy Paugh, and Ted Noble; son-in-law Scott Paugh, daughter-in-law Brenda Noble; grandchildren Katie and Alan Paugh, and Nate and Pete Noble; brother-in law Les Mosher, niece Doreen Louderback, and nephew Doug Mosher. Born April 11, 1934 in Wayland, NY, Roger was raised in Avoca, NY. He graduated from Avoca High School in 1952 and completed four years in the U.S. Navy as a 2<sup>nd</sup> class fire control tech. After graduating with the Bucknell University class of 1960 with a B.S. in E.E., Roger went to work for IBM in Owego, NY, Federal Systems Division on the Orbiting Astronomical Observatory and Apollo Moon Program Development. He transferred to Boulder in 1966 in quality control management, being one of the first to occupy the new Boulder facility of IBM. He concluded his years with IBM as a programming instructor during the company reorganization.

After he retired from IBM in 1990, Roger and his wife Carol moved to Buena Vista in 1992, where he continued to pursue his love of fishing, hunting, and bird-watching. He was a member of Mountain Heights Church and Mount Princeton Masonic Lodge #49, and was a regular at Loback's Bakery. He was also a 50-year member of Avoca American Legion Post #1315.
